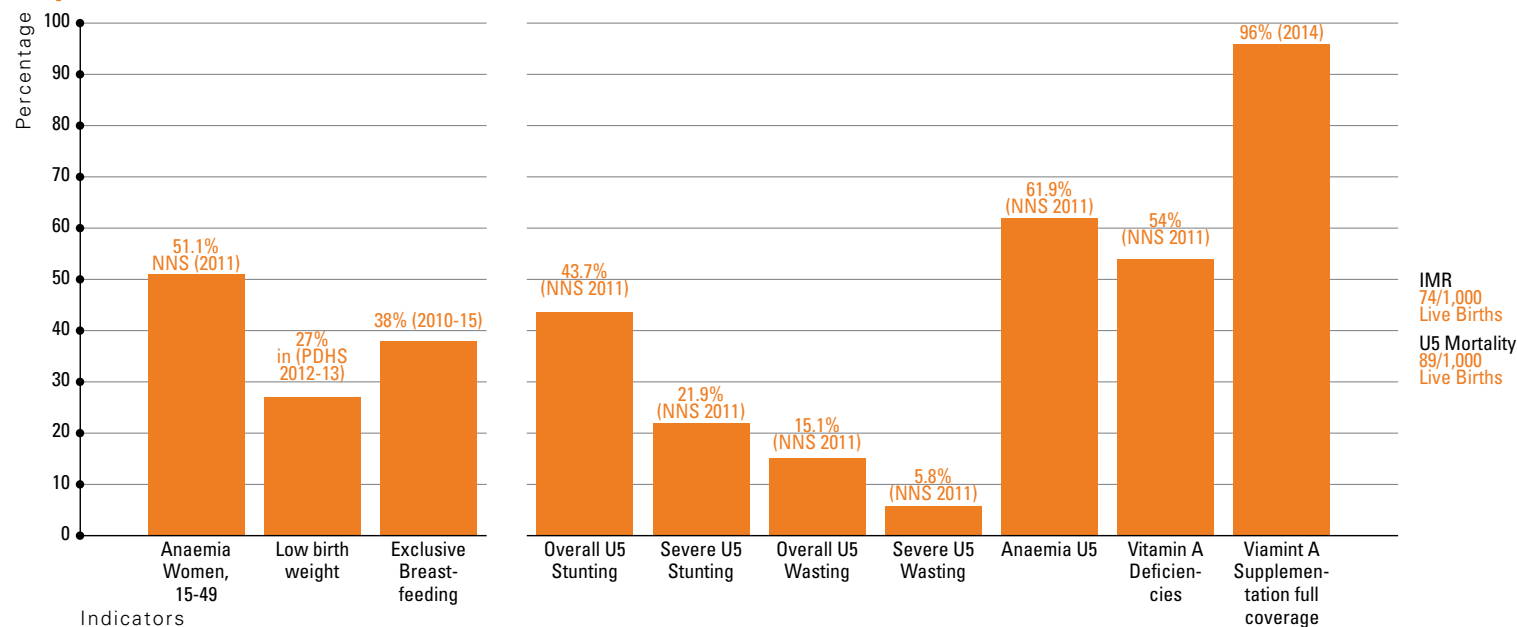

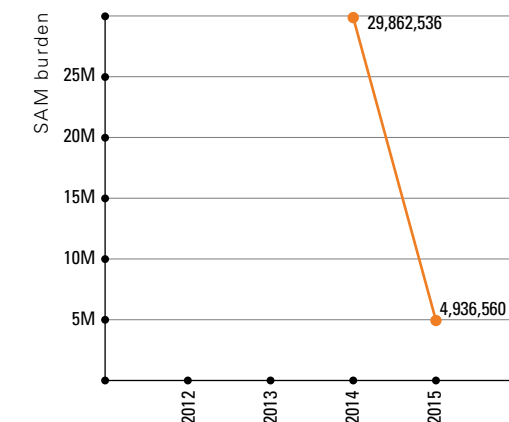

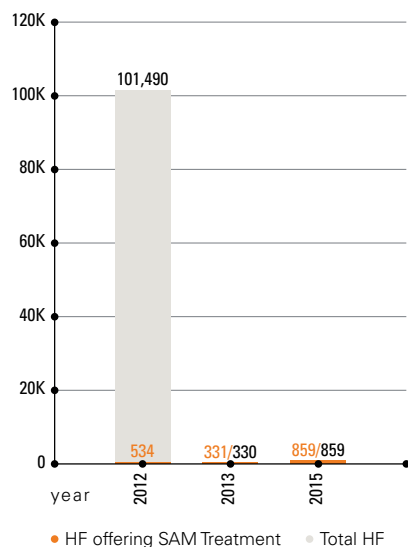

% of Facilities Offering SAM Treatment, by Year, 2010-2015

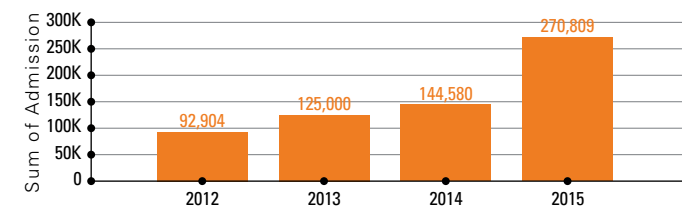
